RE: Proposed Designations in South Dakota for the PM2.5 Standard

Dear Administrator Roberts:

Thank you for your letter asking Governor Rounds to provide the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) with the appropriate recommendations for designating areas of the state for the fine particulate (PM2.5) National Ambient Air Quality Standard. Governor Rounds has previously delegated the authority to determine and submit these designations for South Dakota to the Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR).

EPA revised the particulate matter standard in 2006 by reducing the 24-hour standard for PM2.5. DENR operates a network of monitoring sites which began collecting PM2.5 data in 1999. The sampling network includes sites in several counties to meet the monitoring goals of high concentration, population, source impact, background and regional transport. The population of these counties with air monitoring sites represents about 50 percent of the state's population. See Attachment 1 for a map of the state showing the counties with PM2.5 monitoring data.

The average 24-hour concentration for each site was calculated as the three-year average of the yearly 98 percentile concentration (see Attachment 2). The PM2.5 data collected in the state during the years of 2004 to 2006 show no 24-hour concentration levels that exceed the revised 24-hour standard. DENR expects future sampling will continue to show the same results. As required by Section 107(d)(1) of the Clean Air Act, I recommend that EPA designate all counties in South Dakota as attaining the 24-hour standard for PM2.5. See Attachment 3 for a complete list of proposed designations for the counties in South Dakota.

The highest calculated 24-hour 98 percentile average was recorded at the Sioux Falls Hilltop site and Watertown site. Both had a concentration level of 24 micrograms per cubic meter. Attachment 4 contains a PM2.5 data summary report AMP 450 printed from the Air Quality Systems. This report was used to calculate the 24-hour concentrations.

Thank you again for the opportunity to propose designations for the revised 24-hour PM2.5 standard. We look forward to EPA's approval of these recommended designations. If there are questions about this notice, please contact Brian Gustafson with DENR at 605-773-3151.




