Dear Mr. Curry,

This letter is submitted to fulfill New Mexico's requirements under Section 107(d)(1) of the Clean Air Act. The Clean Air Act requires all state governors to submit initial designations within one year of the promulgation of a new or revised National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS). The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency promulgated in December of 2012 a revised NAAQS for particulate matter 2.5 microns in size and less (PM_{2.5}).

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) evaluated 2010 through 2012 ambient monitoring data with respect to the revised PM_{2.5} NAAQS, and finds that all areas of New Mexico within the jurisdiction of NMED are in compliance with the revised PM_{2.5} NAAQS. With regard to the revised PM_{2.5} NAAQS, I recommend attainment status for all areas of New Mexico within the jurisdiction of NMED.
