Dear Administrator McTeer Toney,

This letter is in reply to EPA's letter to Tennessee Governor Bill Haslam of August 19, 2014. That letter outlined EPA's response to Tennessee's initial recommendations of attainment areas for the 2012  $PM_{2.5}$  NAAQS, outlined in our letter of December 9, 2013.

After careful consideration of EPA's response, Tennessee replies that Hamilton, Marion and Sequatchie Counties in Tennessee should be designated as unclassifiable – attainment in that the most recent air monitoring data supports the designation recommendation.

As for the remaining counties in Tennessee, we recommend that EPA exercise its deferral authority in making final designations as we should soon have a complete three year data set to support a final designation.
