Status

This is a new site to the RCRA Corrective Action program. Region 3 has performed a file review at the regional office to present the information in this fact sheet. EPA, with its State partners, is in the process of conducting file reviews and site visits at new sites, not previously evaluated. After the site visit, an Environmental Indicator Report will be prepared. Once submitted, EPA will evaluate the need for any further corrective action to ensure protection of human health and the environment and update this fact sheet.

Facility Description

The Fairless Hills, Bucks County, Pennsylvania facility has been in operation since August 1, 1988 and consists of 2.4 acres. There are three identified Solid Waste Management Units at the facility: one 15,000 gallon aboveground spent mineral spirits tank, one 20,000 gallon aboveground spent ethylene glycol tank, and one container storage area.

This Facility is an accumulation point for spent solvents and waste antifreeze (ethylene glycol) generated by Safety-Kleen customers. All wastes are ultimately shipped to a recycling facility and then returned to the customer as product.
