Status

EPA conducted a thorough site inspection of the Facility, and evaluated past and current environmental cleanup activities, current operating procedures, and environmental monitoring data. Based on this evaluation, EPA believes that the current clean-up action is properly addressing the contamination at the Facility.

PADEP will determine whether institutional controls are required after a review of all information required for the final clean-up report.

Facility Description

Spectrum Controls, Inc. manufactures and assembles electronic filters. The facility was formerly owned by AMP Corporation, which sold to Spectrum in March 1999. Groundwater is contaminated from past leaks. The groundwater contaminant plume is contained on site. On-site groundwater is not used for any purpose. In 1995, TYCO Electronics began a groundwater clean-up by installing and operating a pump and treat system.

A groundwater contaminant plume contains 1,1-Dichloroethene (1,1-DCE) and 1,1,1-Trichloroethane (1,1,1-TCA) above protective screening levels. The contamination was confined to the facility area, centered around recovery well (RW-2).
