The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the *Draft Pompton Lakes Study Area Corrective Measures Implementation Work Plan* dated September 2015 submitted by Chemours. Chemours prepared the draft CMI WP pursuant to the Module III Supplement Corrective Action Requirements, Pompton Lake Study Area Including Acid Brook Delta Sediments and Upland Soil Areas dated May 2015. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) have also reviewed the CMI WP and their input is reflected in EPA's comments. The USFWS comment letter dated February 12, 2016 has also been included for your information.

Pursuant to the RCRA HSWA Permit Modified Compliance Schedule (Section B) dated May 4, 2010; Chemours should address EPA's comments and resubmit a revised CMI WP no later than 30 days from receipt of the written comments.
