

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the amended Closure Report submitted by Caribe General Electric Products (CGE). The Closure Plan and Report were submitted to address clean closure of the Container Storage Area, the Inactive Subsurface Leach Field System (LFS), the Sediment Tank, the Septic Tank, and the Bright Dipping Area. The EPA has determined that CGE has met the requirements specified in the approved closure plan, as stipulated in 40 C.F.R. Parts 265.111 and 112, Subpart G, and the approved Closure Report dated January 23, 1994. This decision was made based on reported surface and subsurface soil sampling data which show concentrations of volatile organic and inorganic parameters were below the EPA's Soil Screening Levels (SSLs). Please submit a Closure Certification within 60 days of the receipt of this letter as stipulated in 40 C.F.R. Part 265.115.

Caribe GE is subject to comply with the Closure/Post-Closure care requirements as specified in 40 C.F.R. Part 265.117 through 120. If you have any question regarding this matter please contact me at (212)637-4136.
