

**11 CSR 50-2.350 Applicability of Motor Vehicle
Emission Inspection**

(1) The requirements in 11 CSR 50-2.010 through 11 CSR 50-2.320, 11 CSR 50-2.340, and the following rules 11 CSR 50-2.350 through 11 CSR 50-2.410 are applicable to vehicles which require an emission inspection:

(A) All motor vehicles registered in the Counties of St. Charles, Jefferson, St. Louis, and in the City of St. Louis, powered totally or partially by gasoline shall be given an emission inspection as part of the annual safety inspection after Dec. 31, 1983;

(B) A safety inspection shall be conducted before conducting an emission inspection;

(C) An inspection station operator licensed to conduct only safety inspections shall not conduct an inspection on a vehicle requiring both a safety and emission inspection;

(D) Vehicles powered in part by gasoline shall be emission tested only in a gasoline-powered mode of operation: and

(E) The following classes of vehicles are exempt from the emission inspection:

1. Motor vehicles registered pursuant to a gross vehicle weight in excess of 6,000 pounds as otherwise provided by law and motor vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating in excess of 8,500 pounds not licensed by gross weight.

2. Motorcycles, dirt bikes, and motortricycles;

3. Model-year vehicles prior to 1971;

4. School buses;

5. Diesel powered vehicles; and

6. New motor vehicles not previously registered.
