

## 11 CSR 50-2.390 Safety/Emission Stickers

(1) A safety/emission sticker shall be affixed by the inspector/mechanic to each motor vehicle which is subject to and passes the safety/emission test or has been given a low emission tune-up. The safety/emission sticker shall be affixed in accordance with regulations prescribed for safety inspection stickers. Motor vehicles without glazing must have a securely mounted transparent material, such as rigid plastic, attached in a conspicuous location in the driver area for affixing the safety/emission sticker to the vehicle.

(2) A certificate of approval (white copy of MVI-2 form) which is required by the Department of Revenue in order to obtain valid vehicle registration shall be issued by the inspector/mechanic to a vehicle owner whose vehicle has passed the safety/emission test or has been given a low emission tune-up.

(3) Safety/emission stickers shall be purchased by inspection station operators from the Missouri State Highway Patrol at a cost of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per book for twenty (20) stickers.
