

**11 CSR 50-2.420 Procedures for Conducting
Only Emission Tests**

(1) An emission inspection may be conducted without conducting a safety inspection if the vehicle owner provides a certificate of approval issued within the past sixty (60) days showing only a safety inspection was conducted and proof the vehicle was purchased from an owner who does not reside in the area described in 11 CSR 50-2.350(1)(A). Emission inspections only may be conducted in other circumstances if authorized by the Missouri State Highway Patrol.

(A) The inspector/mechanic shall record by hand the safety information including: the date, the inspection station number and safety inspection sticker on the Emission Only Approval Certificate.

(B) A safety/emission sticker shall be issued and affixed above the safety sticker for the vehicle if it passes the inspection as prescribed in 11 CSR 50-2.390.

(C) The statutory fee shall be charged for the emission inspection.

(D) An inspection station operator may obtain a reimbursement for the safety portion of the sticker not used by forwarding the second copy of the Emission Only Approval Certificate to MVI-GHQ after patrol personnel have audited the form. MVI-GHQ will forward a safety inspection sticker for each Emission Only Approval Certificate used and verified by the Missouri State Highway Patrol.
