

DESIGNATIONS IN US EPA REGION 9 FOR THE PRIMARY ANNUAL FINE PARTICLE (PM_{2.5}) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

-  Nonattainment/Moderate (2012 NAAQS)
-  Nonattainment (1997 NAAQS)
-  Unclassifiable/Attainment

The 2012 primary annual fine particle (PM_{2.5}) national ambient air quality standard (NAAQS) is 12 micrograms per cubic meter (µg/m³). Areas violating the NAAQS are designated "Nonattainment." Other Pacific territories under EPA Region 9 jurisdiction (not shown on map) are designated "Unclassifiable/Attainment." Designations are effective April 15, 2015.
