We are pleased to inform you that Bovano Industries, Inc. has attained a "YE" determination for the two RCRA Corrective Action environmental indicators: (1) Current Human Exposures Under Control, (2) Migration of Contaminated Groundwater Under Control. Based on your Current Condition Report dated October 20, 2000, EPA agrees that the facility does not pose any significant risk to the human health and the groundwater within the facility and downgradient of the facility is in compliance with the applicable federal and state health based standards.

Please be aware that EPA's determination is based on the most current information that we have. If the condition at the facility changes such that it will no longer meet the "YE" determination, EPA may require remedial activities to ensure the site will continue to meet the environmental indicators.
