The Department of Environmental Protection, Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division (the "Department") acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated March 24, 2009. This letter requested one hundred twenty (120) day extension to the deadline for the submission of the ecological and human health based remedial goals for the sediments within the tidal flats and 008 outfall area as required by Condition No. III.D.2. of the RCRA Stewardship Permit (Permit No. DEP/HWM/CS-134-003 issued October 2, 2008) for the facility located at 550 Main Street in Stratford, CT. The letter of request was submitted pursuant to Condition No. I.E.22

This request is hereby approved. The Permittee shall submit the ecological and human health based remedial goals for the sediments within the tidal flats and 008 outfall area for the Commissioner's review and written review as required by Condition No. III.D.2. of the permit no later than August 3, 2009.

In addition, attached to the March 24, 2009 letter were tables for the ecological and human health based remedial goals for the groundwater migrating off the site to the tidal flats and other nearby surface waters in accordance with the requirements of Condition No. III.D.1. of the permit. Please note, this letter does not constitute an approval of these remedial goals. This information was forwarded to the project manager, Kenneth Feathers of the Remediation Division of the Bureau of Water Protection and Land Reuse for review and written approval.

To ensure more efficient review of your submittals, please submit all corrective action plans or documents required by the permit to Kenneth Feathers. Any requests for extensions or permit modifications may continue to be directed to Lauren Kostiuk of the Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division of the Bureau of Materials Management and Compliance Assurance.
