

Dear Mr. Lederle:

The Department of Environmental Protection, Waste Engineering and Enforcement Division (the "Department") acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated January 26, 2009 for a modification to the Compliance Schedule for the facility located at 550 Main Street in Stratford, CT. This application was submitted pursuant to Condition No. I.E.22 of the RCRA Stewardship Permit (Permit No. DEP/HWM/CS-134-003 issued October 2, 2008).

This request is hereby approved; the following conditions of the permit are hereby revised:  
Condition No. III.A.:

*All conditions set forth in Section III.A. of this permit, shall be conducted within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of the closing of the sale of the facility, but no later than October 1, 2009. Otherwise, the Permittee may be subject to formal enforcement actions.*

Condition No. III.B.:

*All conditions set forth in Section III.B. of this permit, shall be conducted within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of the closing of the sale of the facility, but no later than October 1, 2009. Otherwise, the Permittee may be subject to formal enforcement actions.*

Condition No. III.C:

*All conditions set forth in Section III.C. of this permit, shall be conducted within ninety (90) calendar days from the date of the closing of the sale of the facility, but no later than October 1, 2009. Otherwise, the Permittee may be subject to formal enforcement actions.*
