I also confirmed with ISO NE that Merrimack, Schiller and Newington all have Capacity Supply Obligations (CSO's) through May 2021. That doesn't necessarily mean that they will commit to not retiring until then, but they do have the ability to sit still and receive capacity payments until then. We will find out next month whether they have CSO's for the June 2021 – May 2022 period.
