Subject: Name Changes to three Fossil Fuel Electric Generating
Stations State Discharge Permits

Dear Mses. Landis and Newman:

Please reference the letter to you from David M. Webster of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) dated January 18, 2018. In the letter, EPA acknowledged the name changes for three new Hampshire fossil fuel electric generating stations with individual NPDES permits as listed below.

NH0001465 – Merrimack Station, Bow, NH
NH0001601 – Newington Station, Newington, NH
NH0001473 – Schiller Station, Portsmouth, NH

The name changes, from Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) to Granite Shore Power LLC (GSP), were described in the letters from you both to EPA dated November 10, 2017 and January 10, 2018. DES hereby also acknowledges the name changes for the above three permits and that as of January 10, 2018 GSP Merrimack LLC, GSP Newington LLC and GSP Schiller LLC will bear all responsibilities for the above named facilities and all liability pursuant to the state discharge permits .
