I wanted to clarify that due to the concern about solids buildup in the slag settling pond and the release of pollutants in the sediment, especially during and after storm events, DES would like us to consider requiring monitoring for metals in slag settling pond outfall 003A.

Please let me know if that captures it. Thanks.
