The meeting was requested by PSNH. The meeting objective was to discuss/determine a course of action that will allowed PSNH to operate Merrimack Station's Flue Gas Desulfurization Scrubber (FGD) system. PSNH was direct by the NH legislature to build the FGD and have it in operation by 2013. PSNH is well ahead of schedule, and will be ready to start operational testing of the FGD by mid-2011.

PSNH is concern that since: (1) Merrimack Station's NPDES permit does not contain effluent limits for the FGD, and (2) a reissued NPDES permit for Merrimack Station is months (if not a year) away, PSNH will not be allowed to operate the FGD.

It was stated during the meeting that NHDES will support PSNH's efforts to

place the FGD in operation. It was further stated M. Walls and other NHDES staff would be contacting Ira, Region 1 attorneys and possible other Region staff concerning how to get the FGD operational.
