Hi Jeff,

Thanks for your insight today. I forgot to ask you one last question. The current Draft Permit Fact Sheet for Merrimack Station intakes the following:

The NHDES Water Division classifies the Hooksett Pool of the Merrimack River as impaired. New Hampshire's CWA § 303(d) List of Impaired Waters Assessment Unit ID for this section of the Merrimack River is NHIMP700060802-02. This section is listed as not supporting fish consumption due to elevated mercury levels. The assessment lists atmospheric deposition as a probable source of the impairment.

I looked at the 2012 303(d) list and couldn't find anything about mercury. Would you check? Maybe I'm not looking at the right document. Thank you!

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
