This minor permit modification is issued in accordance with section 22a-430 of Chapter 446k, Connecticut General Statutes ("CGS"), section 22a-430-4(p)(5) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies ("RCSA") adopted thereunder, as amended, and Section 402(b) of the Clean Water Act, as amended 33 USC 1251, *et. seq.*, and pursuant to an approval dated September 26, 1973, by the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency for the State of Connecticut to administer a NPDES permit program.

On March 30, 2011, NRG Devon Operations Inc. ("Permittee") submitted Application No. 201102260 to modify its existing permit by the removal of two permitted discharge points. The Permittee shall comply with all conditions of Permit No. CT0003107 issued on February 4, 2007 with the following modifications:

- 1. DSN 013-B (Table F) is removed from the permit. This was an internal monitoring point for stormwater from the South end of the tank farm and from condensate associated with the steam generating units. However, the subject tank farm and the steam generating units have been removed. The stormwater now generated and collected from this area is directed to DSN 013 and managed under a general permit.*
- 2. DSN 018 (Table G) is removed from the permit. This was a final monitoring point for stormwater from the fuel receiving area dike. However, the fuel receiving area has been cleaned and dismantled and the containment drain plug associated with DSN 018-1 has been removed. This discharge no longer exists.*

The Commissioner reserves the right to make appropriate revisions to the permit in order to establish any appropriate effluent limitations, schedules of compliance, or other provisions that may be authorized under the Clean Water Act or the Connecticut General Statutes or regulations adopted thereunder, as amended. The permit as modified under this paragraph may also contain any other requirements of the Clean Water Act or Connecticut General Statutes or regulations adopted thereunder which are then applicable.

All other terms and conditions of Permit No. CT0003107 issued on February 4, 2007 shall continue in full force and effect.

This minor modification is hereby issued on *May 17, 2011.*
