The Department of Environmental Conservation's Watershed Management Division recently concluded a 30-day public notice comment period (September 30, 2015) for revocation of the above referenced National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) discharge permit. No comments were received during the comment period. This is final notification that NPDES discharge permit 3-1558 issued to the City of Burlington is hereby revoked. The City of Burlington no longer has authorization to discharge treated contaminated groundwater from the Moran Plant project. Submittal of monthly monitoring reports is no longer required. Annual operating fees were current at the time of revocation.
