Dear Mr. Hamann:

Pursuant to your electronic mail message sent to me on December 20th, the Department of Environmental Protection is hereby retiring combination Integrated Compliance Information System (ICIS) permit #MEU508258/Maine Waste Discharge License #W-008258 (permit) last issued to MGA Cast Stone Inc. on January 5, 2016. The permit authorized the daily maximum discharge of up to 4,000 gallons per day (gpd) of treated block wash waters associated with a commercial architectural and concrete block manufacturing facility into a sub-surface waste water disposal system in Oxford, Maine.

The Department understands all waste waters from the MGA Cast Stone Inc. facility are now being conveyed to the waste water treatment facility that is owned and operated by the Town of Oxford, Maine. The discharge from the Oxford facility is regulated via MEPES permit #ME0102873 last issued by the Department for a five-year term on June 10, 2016.

We will be inactivating ICIS permit #MEU508258/WDL #W-008258 in our database so that Discharge Monitoring Reports and billing statements will not be sent to you in the future. By copy of this letter, we are notifying the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that we are terminating the MEPDES permit.
