Dear Ms. Liguori:

The Department is in receipt of your December 11, 2018, letter requesting the Department retire the above referenced MEPDES permit/WDL for the Otis Hydro Station located in Livermore Falls, Maine. Your letter indicates the facility no longer uses river water in the heat exchanger for the combined bearings as a cooling medium. By this letter, the Department is retiring MEPDES/WDL #ME0036714/#W008067 last renewed on February 7, 2014.

We will be inactivating the facility in our database so that Discharge Monitoring Reports and billing statements are not sent to you in the future.

By copy of this letter, we are notifying the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) that we are terminating your MEPDES permit/WDL.

Please be advised that a permit/license may be needed from this Department for any future discharge of pollutants from this facility to the surface waters or ground waters of the State of Maine, either under current ownership or new ownership. Any new permit/license would be based on the characteristics of the effluent being discharges and the impacts of the discharge on the quality of the receiving water.
