Permit Retirement

Dear Ms. Bayley:

By this letter, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection is retiring the above referenced MEPDES permit/WDL (permit hereinafter) that was lasted issued to Bayley's Quality Seafood on August 14, 2018, for a five-year term. Department rule Chapter 2, *Rule Concerning The processing of Applications and Other Administrative Matters*, Section 21(A) states in relevant part as follows:

- **21. License Renewals, Amendments and Transfers.** Applications for renewed, amended or transferred licenses are subject to all of the provisions of this rule and the following requirements:
 - A. **Renewals.** Renewal applications must be submitted prior to the expiration of the existing license. If a renewal application is not timely submitted prior to expiration of the existing license, or is timely submitted but not accepted as complete for processing in accordance with section 11(B) of this rule, the license lapses.

The above referenced permit expired on August 14, 2023, and the Department's records indicate, that as of the date of this letter, more than eight (8) months after the expiration date of the permit, a renewal application has not been filed to renew the permit. Therefore, the permit has lapsed and is no longer valid. We will be inactivating it in our database so that Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) and billing statements will no longer be sent to Bayley's Quality Seafood. We are also notifying the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency of the permit retirement.

Should Bayley's Quality Seafood or another entity want to discharge process waste water to surface waters of the state or a sub-surface waste water disposal system, from the facility located at 314 Pine Point Road in the Town of Scarborough, it would need to file an application with the Department for a new permit.
