Notice of Public Hearing

The Vermont Agency of Natural Resources will hold a public hearing, in accordance with 10 V.S.A. §1263(b), and Section 13.3 of the Vermont Water Pollution Control Permit Regulations on its tentative determination to issue a discharge permit for an application filed by:

Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC
320 Governor Hunt Road
Vernon, VT 05354

The Agency of Natural Resources proposes to issue a discharge permit to Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee, LLC for the discharge of effluent from activities associated with electro-generation and nuclear power facility operations to the Connecticut River. This is a renewal and modification of an existing permit.

A public hearing will be held on August 20, 2014 at 6:00 PM at the Vernon Elementary School (Cafeteria), 381 Governor Hunt Road, Vernon, Vermont to receive public comments on the draft permit. Any person may submit oral and/or written comments at the public hearing.

In addition, any person may submit written comments by 4:30 PM on August 27, 2014. This extends the comment period stated in the public notice dated July 7, 2014. The written comments should be sent to:
