Re: Notice of Termination under the Remediation General Permit (RGP) – Authorization #MAG910742, for the Broadway Gas and Service site located in Everett, MA

Dear Mr. Fayad:

This confirms receipt of a Notice of Termination (NOT) dated September 21, 2017 for the site referenced above. Based on the review of your NOT, this site is no longer subject to the terms and conditions of the Remediation General Permit (RGP). Coverage will be terminated as of the date of this letter. Please note that further discharges, if any, from this site may require coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permitting program.

If, in the future, there is a discharge from this site eligible for a general permit, a new Notice of Intent (NOI) will be required. A new discharge not otherwise eligible for a general permit into waters of the United States from this site, must submit an application for discharge to the appropriate permitting agency at least 180 days in advance of the proposed discharge (see CFR §122.21(c)(1)). Any proposed new discharge which meets the definition of a new source, 40 CFR §122.2, must meet the requirements of any applicable new source performance standards for your industry, promulgated under the authority of 33 U.S.C. Section 1316, and shall protect state water quality standards. Any treatment required to be installed to meet new source performance standards, state water quality, or any other requirement of a permit would have to be installed prior to discharge to the waters. Discharge to waters of the United States without obtaining a permit would violate Section 301(a) of the Clean Water Act, and would subject you to the civil and/or criminal enforcement provisions of Section 309 of the Act.
