Ladies and Gentlemen:

On behalf of our client, the President and Fellows of Harvard College acting by and through Harvard Engineering and Utilities (E&U) and Harvard Capital Projects (HCP), Haley & Aldrich, Inc. (Haley & Aldrich) is submitting this Notice of Change (NOC) for notification of an extended discharge interruption and change of administrative information. The purpose of this letter is to provide supplemental information for submission of this NOC.

Interruption of discharge started on 22 December 2017 due to the completion of the Western Avenue Utility Crossing portion of the project. The Package E portion of the project (added to the Authorization to Discharge in a Notice of Change submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency on 5 February 2018, is tentatively planned to restart in June 2018, which will be an interruption in discharge of greater than 90 days. As discussed with your office, following restart of temporary construction dewatering, compliance sampling will consist of a one-time sampling of the influent and effluent on the first day of discharge and one additional sampling of the influent and effluent within the first week of discharge, pursuant to NPDES Permit No. MAG910000 Section 4.3.1.a.i. Sampling will continue on a monthly basis thereafter.

Additionally, this NOC serves to update the contact for the President and Fellows of Harvard College. The new contact is Danny Rico, Senior Project Manager, as listed on the attached form.




