Schiller Station  
NPDES Permit No. NH0001473

Public Service Company of New Hampshire (PSNH) decided to deactivate an auxiliary steam plant at Schiller Station in the summer of 1987. The three discharges associated with the "Dock Boiler House" were retained in the NPDES permit in the event the facility was revitalized. It is now evident that the plant will remain retired and outfalls 007, 008, and 009 will no longer be necessary. PSNH is now notifying EPA that piping modifications are presently being made to eliminate the discharge of process water and thereby eliminate the outfalls.

It was agreed during conversations between Mr. Allan Palmer of PSNH and Mr. T. Landry of EPA and Mr. J. Andrews of NHDES that this matter could be handled as a minor permit modification.
