Subject: Schiller Station Oil Release

Ladies, Schiller Station (NH0001473) in Portsmouth reports a minor release of oil from a storm drain this morning. It appears that the oil is discharging from the Unit 5 roof drains (via Outfall 006). Station personnel believe the source is an air vent from the turbine lube oil storage tanks that may have deposited a small amount of oil on the roof. Containment devices are being deployed, both on the roof and in the river. Appropriate notifications are being made (National Response Center, Coast Guard, DES, EPA, etc.) per the SPCC/OPA Plans, and an effluent sample has been collected to analyze for oil & grease. I will keep you informed as the response proceeds and as more information is learned, and can provide you with a copy of the resultant written report when it becomes available.
