Public Service Company of New Hampshire hereby submits this letter in response to a deficiency noted during the inspection that took place on July 29, 2008, and, in your letter dated July 31, 2008 which stated:

During the inspection the following deficiency was noted:

PSNH has not been completing the DMRs correctly per the EPA's instructions. A copy of DES's Track 2000 Database Monthly Compliance Report was provided and reviewed with the facility. Specifically, the December 2007 DMR did not specify the flow units. More attention should be exercised since PSNH is certifying that the DMR information is true, accurate and complete. Upon DES's request an amended DMR was received on July 29, 2008.

Subsequent to the inspection PSNH remitted corrected copies of the DMR forms plus a letter of explanation to EPA (cc: NHDES) and sent electronically to NHDES. Copies of the letter and corrected DMRs have been enclosed herein.
