EPA has received Public Service of New Hampshire's letter dated December 10, 2007. That letter requested an extension of 90 days from the due date of April 7, 2008, in order to respond to EPA's information request dated October 31, 2007.

EPA has agreed to Public Service of New Hampshire's extension request. However, this extension applies only to the technical information portion of the Supplemental Information Request. Public Service of New Hampshire now has until July 7, 2008, to respond to the technical portion of EPA's information request. The portion of the Supplemental Information Request requiring submission of biological data is still due by April 7, 2008.

Please be advised, since the original NPDES reapplications for both these power stations are over a decade old, EPA is reviewing the accuracy of these reapplications. It is expected EPA will soon formally request updates of those reapplications.
