Hey Chris:

EPA is putting together a team to begin the NPDES permit renewal process for Schiller Station (400 Gosling Road, Portsmouth NH), which withdraws and discharges water to the Piscataqua River (USGS Hydrologic Basin Code: 01060003).

The facility is approximately 1 mile downstream of EP Newington Energy Facility, permit # NH0023361 We completed an informal section 7 consultation on EP Newington on August 27, 2012.

Certainly the potential impacts from Schiller Station will be different from Newington Energy, but I wanted to confirm that the protected species and waterbody characteristics documented for Newington will be the same for Schiller Station.
