Reference: National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. NH0001473

Your letter of August 16, 2002, requested modifications to the intake of Unit 4 at Schiller Station. The first requested modification was to employ a redesigned intake screen to mitigate lobster impingement. The second modification requested the removal of the second set trash racks within the screen house. EPA New England has reviewed the requested modifications and takes no exception to them. Public Service of New Hampshire is authorized; therefore, to proceed with the requested modifications. EPA has also determined no modification of NPDES Permit No. NH0001473 is required.
