This permit consists of 24 pages in Part I including effluent limitations, monitoring requirements, etc., and 22 pages in Part II (dated April 6, 1990) including General Conditions and Definitions, 7 pages of a May 31, 1991 Minor Modification, and 1 page of a January 24, 1995 Minor Modification. These conditions remain in effect for the new owner.
