Dear Mr. Parts:

This is an *interim* response to your FOIA request of November 23, 2020, **for specific records related to the Schiller Station Power Plant in Portsmouth, NH, from July 20, 2020 to the present.**

We have uploaded, into FOIAonline, **5** non-privileged documents responsive to your request. We are withholding in part certain information contained in an additional **5** documents pursuant to Exemption 6 – personal privacy, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6). Exemption (6) protects information when the disclosure of such “would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.” 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6). See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(8)(A)(i)(I).”

This is an *interim* response only. Upon providing you with a *final* response, to the extent there are any adverse determinations you may appeal such determinations at that time. Information on how to appeal any adverse determinations will be provided along with the final response letter and the bill for collection.

An additional extension of time will be necessary to complete the processing of your request. The remaining responsive records are currently under legal review. A final response is expected on or before **January 11, 2021.**
