7b. WLA Assessment

The Town has implemented an educational pamphlet program to distribute educational brochures to 330 resident dwellings in the Jordan Pond watershed area. The pamphlets include information asking residents not to over-fertilize their lawns and to use phosphorous free fertilizers. Jordan Pond is a close tributary to Lake Quinsigamond. The program effectiveness will be evaluated and implemented in other key watershed areas that contribute to TMDL water bodies. Program modifications and improvements will be made as necessary.

Part IV. Summary of Information Collected and Analyzed

Water samples were tested weekly during the bathing season at Sunset Beach for E Coli and Total Coliform levels. The Town Health Department has reported that no violations of the water quality standards for bathing beaches were detected at Sunset Beach during 2003.
