

The town of Westport has taken strides to implement the NPDES OII Small MS4 General Permit. The town of Westport is not in compliance with the schedule requirements of the permit.

**BMP 2-2: Storm Water Management Committee**

The Board of Selectmen established a municipal Storm Water Management Program Committee to oversee the town's Phase II program. The committee is comprised of the following town officials: Town Administrator, Highway Surveyor and a representative from the Board of Health, Conservation Commission, and Planning Board. The committee has invited a representative of the Westport River Watershed Alliance to attend the meetings. The Committee will continue to meet at least once each year to oversee and revise the Stormwater Management Program as appropriate and report annually to the selectmen.
