<u>Presentation</u>: Completing a "Notice of Intent (NOI) for Approval to Discharge" under the new Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) General Permit

Small MS4 Permits in Massachusetts and New Hampshire go into effect on July 1, 2018. Within 90 days of that date (October 1, 2018) small MS4s in MA & NH (traditional and non-traditional) must submit an NOI to EPA for approval to discharge under this new permit.

Managers and operators of traditional or non-traditional municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s), including Department of Public Works directors and staff, town counsel and elected officials.
