Subject: Extending the Public Comment Period for EPA-R01-OW-2024-0493

This memorandum authorizes the extension of the public comment period for EPA-R01-OW-2024-0493 by an additional 90 days to May 21, 2025.

On November 22, 2024, Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Region 1 provided notice of availability of a Draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for the discharge of stormwater from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) that covers "traditional" (i.e., cities and towns) and "non-traditional" (i.e., Federal and state agencies) MS4s in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts ("Draft Permit").

As initially published in the Federal Register, comments on the Draft Permit were to be submitted to the EPA on or before February 20, 2025 (a 90-day public comment period). EPA is extending the public comment period for 90 days. The Draft Permit will be open for public comment from November 22, 2024 to May 21, 2025. If EPA holds a public hearing on the Draft Permit, EPA will provide adequate notice of the hearing on its website, on this docket, and via email to interested parties.

DATES: Comments must be received on or before May 21, 2025.

The written comment is considered the official comment and should include discussion of all points you wish to make. The EPA will generally not consider comments or comment contents located outside of the primary submission (i.e. on the web, cloud, or other file sharing system).
