Thank you for your comments on the Town of Swampscott's Notice of Intent for Coverage under the 2016 Massachusetts MS4 Permit. EPA has determined the Notice of Intent submitted by the Town of Swampscott (as amended) is complete and indicates the Town of Swampscott will adhere to all permit terms and schedules. Many of your comments were specific to the manner in which Swampscott administers and prioritizes their stormwater program to meet permit requirements and would best be addressed through comments on the Town of Swampscott's Stormwater Management Program (SWMP). The permit requires the Town of Swampscott to allow the public to comment on their SWMP, which must be completed by July 1, 2019.
