The city had made repairs to "access points" cut in the fence by vandals/scrappers at Aerovox in the areas you observed during your last visit. The vandals have continued to cut new access points in new locations, including fencing on Precix property. Vandals continue to remove metals from outside the Areovox facility during the night hours. Mr. Andreoni is concerned that they will attack his property next.
