Dear Mr. aRusso:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the GZA GeoEnvironmental, Inc. (GZA) April 26, 1993 letter to you which responds to EPA and the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) comments to the December 1992 Wetland Delineation Work Plan. EPAs comments and conditional approval to the Wetland Delineation Work Plan were presented in a letter from EPA to you dated February 22, 1993.

GZA has adequately addressed EPAs concerns and EPA has no additional comments to the Work Plan. For this task, EPA will not require 3 weeks advance notification. One week advance notification will be adequate.


EPA approval to proceed with the wetland delineation does not mean that EPA concurs with GZAs responses to RIDEMs comments. RIDEM concurrence must be obtained separately.

After RIDEM concurrence is obtained, you will need to prepare an addendum to the work plan. The addendum will be added to the Administrative Record for the Central Landfill Site.
