The Rhode Island Historical Preservation and Heritage Commission has reviewed the above-referenced Phase 1a report, and we find it to be an acceptable assessment of the cultural resources expected in the project area.

As the Phase 1a report states on page 21, currently submerged areas in the ponds have the potential to contain archaeological resources. This is an aspect of the project that is going to require careful consideration, and we recommend that it be mentioned in the final paragraph of the abstract.
