Update on the Efforts to Address Dioxin Contamination in the Woonasquatucket River
EPA to Hold Public Informational Meeting July 21, 2011

(Boston-July 20, 2011) EPA New England announces an informational public meeting at 7 pm, Thursday, July 21, 2011 to be held at the North Providence Town Hall, Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, 2000 Smith Street, North Providence, RI 02911.

Representatives from the US EPA, RI Department of Environmental Management and RI Department of Health will provide an update and answer questions about environmental investigations and actions at the **Centredale Manor Restoration Project Superfund Site**.

Items to be discussed at the meeting include:

- The four short-term cleanup actions taken;
- The Remedial Investigation results, including the type and extent of site contamination and the site's potential human health and ecological risks;
- The spectrum of possible cleanup approaches identified in the Feasibility Study; and,
- The next steps in the Superfund cleanup process.
