Excerpted from Water Board Meeting minutes of June 29, 1993

D. P. A letter from Fire Chief Henry Openshaw requesting cement lining of Sawyer St. at the location of the P. C. B. burning site was read. Mr. Brightman mentioned to Mr. Hasey that he thought that main should be replaced with a brand-new pipe. Mr. Hasey explained that representatives of D.E.P. requested that be reconsidered and when the Fire Dept. received D. E. P. 's request the Fire Dept. modified their request to the Water Dept. complying with their request by cement lining.

Mr. Hasey mentioned that there were no funds in the Budget for this year to accommodate this cement lining. D.E.P. (Department of Environmental Protection) has been requested to pay for this.

Mr. Brightman suggested that the Water Board reject the Fire Chief's request and that a new 12" line be installed down Sawyer St. as was previously decided. The age of the line was discussed. Mr. Hasey had investigated it and found that it was put in in 1911.

Mr. Brightman said that the only reason that line was needed was for the PCB's.

Councillor Rogers made a motion to reject Fire Chief Openshaw's request.

Mr. Kruger seconded the motion. All in favor. Aye. So Moved.

Mr. Hasey asked the Board if he should also tell Chief Openshaw that the Water Board will demand that the 12" line be installed all the way back to Acushnet Ave. All members present agreed that he should.
