In response to the proposal that 300,000 cubic yards of PCB contaminated sediment be buried below the riverbed in CAD cells to expedite and economize the remediation process of the Acushnet Estuary Superfund site:

The children of greater New Bedford should not be forsaken for the sake of time and/or money

NO! Do NOT stop removing the PCB's from the Acushnet River!

Without removing the contaminants completely, the threat will not be removed. Burying them deeper in the river would, clearly, be moving things in the wrong direction.
