I have edified myself on the proposed change in procedure for disposing the dredged PCBs from New Bedford Harbor. I realize that, to date, the CADs that have been in place in Boston and other harbors in the US, have remained sealed, at least to the extent of the available analytical tools used to measure for leaked material. However, it is my opinion that a savings of 15% in time and money in utilizing the CAD disposal method is not worth the long term potential of jeopardizing the health and well being of the residents of the New Bedford Harbor area. Please reconsider the original method of disposal: that of shipping the toxic waste off site.
