Upper and Lower New Bedford Harbor Public Comment Period Extended Again

Based on a request from an interested party, the EPA has extended the public comment period by an additional 11 days for the proposed cleanup plan for the upper and lower harbor of the New Bedford Harbor Superfund Site. The extension will allow the public more time to offer comments to the EPA's preferred plan and other alternatives identified and evaluated for addressing site contamination. The closing date of the public comment period is now February 3, 1997. All written comments must be postmarked no later than February 3, 1997, and sent to David Dickerson, EPA Project Manager, JFK Federal Bldg., HBO, Boston, MA 02203

The EPA held a public meeting in early Nov. 1996 and a hearing Nov. 20, 1996 in the New Bedford Vocational Technical High School Library to accept oral and written comments on the proposed plan.
