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**Subject:** Update - Proposed South Terminal - Change in Shellfish Mitigation  
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Cindy et al,

After the State Enhanced Remedy meeting yesterday, I spoke with Chet Myers and Kathleen Ford of MassDMF. The state has decided that there will be no relaying of shellfish for the project. Instead they are proposing to do only seeding. This includes the areas inside and outside of the hurricane barrier. As I understand it, the main reason eliminate relaying inside the barrier is that there is very little area where shellfish don't already exist and would create overcrowding. For the outer harbor, there are not additional shell fish bed sites to relay the existing shellfish particularly because of the limited areas where EPA would allow relaying (no relaying of shellfish with greater PCB levels to shellfish bed areas with lower PCB levels).

We can talk about this at tomorrow's meeting with the state.
