The properties listed in the Memo have not changed, except the current dredging in the EPA Superfund Remedial Area (north of Coggeshall, next to the Sawyer St facility), which is occurring now. EPA is alright with this modification.

Other Navigational Dredging projects has occurred in the Harbor outside the State Enhanced Remedy, but they have received permits to dredge. The disposal falls under the DMMP process which MA CZM set up about ten years ago to deal with disposal of Navigational dredged sediments.

Also, the New Bedford Harbor Master Plan is currently being updated and will include more properties, these properties could then be included in the State Enhanced Remedy with EPA agreement. Not sure if the MOAs between the State - EPA would need to be changed.

Attached is Fig 5.8 from a pdf version of the Master Plan. You should be able to print this out to the size you need. Also, you can change the size of this figure on the computer screen. Let me know if you want me to dig up a paper copy.

"Enhancement" or "Enhancement Work" or "Work" shall mean all or any part of the navigational dredging projects depicted on Figure 5.8 of the New Bedford/Fairhaven Harbor Plan, August 2002, (Attachment A to this Memorandum of Agreement) and as further described on page 52 of that Plan (Attachment B to this Memorandum of Agreement) provided that the dredging projects are conducted entirely within the New Bedford Harbor Superfund Site.

"Enhancement" or "Enhancement Work" or "Work" shall also include the disposal of the sediments dredged as depicted and described in Attachments A and B of this Memorandum of Agreement provided that the disposal facilities and any required mitigation measures and institutional controls are conducted entirely within the New Bedford Harbor Superfund Site and that operation and maintenance of the

disposal facilities is performed in such a way that ensures that the facilities are protective of human health and the environment.


